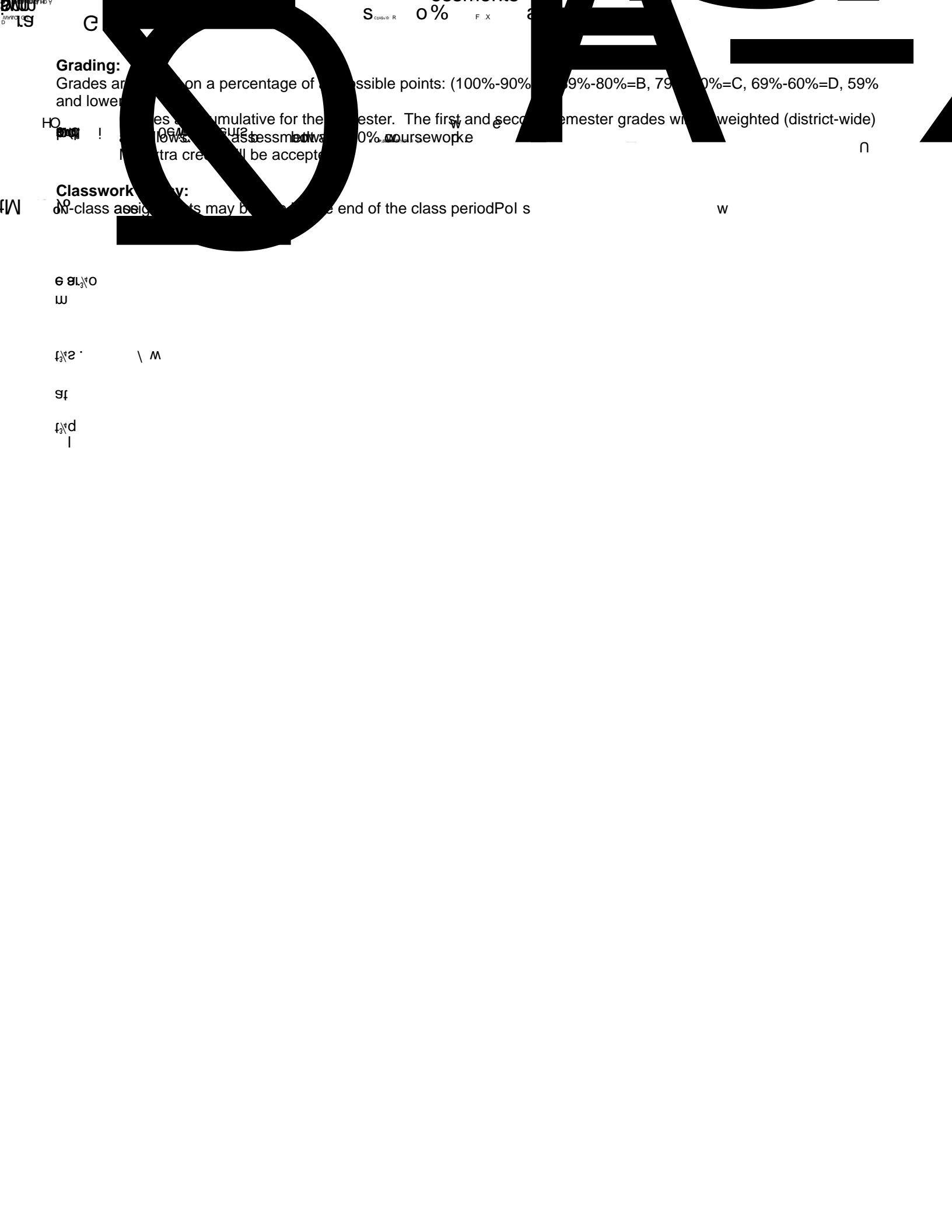

Grading:

Grades are based on a percentage of possible points: (100%-90%=A, 89%-80%=B, 79%-70%=C, 69%-60%=D, 59% and lower=F). Grades are cumulative for the semester. The first and second semester grades will be weighted (district-wide) as follows: 50% assessment, 50% coursework. Extra credit will be accepted.

Classwork Policy:

Out-of-class assignments may be due at the end of the class period. Policies will be discussed in class.

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Reassessment Plan:

The student must initiate contact with the teacher within 5 school days of the assessment score being posted. The student must communicate with the teacher to create a reassessment plan.

Assignment is turned in by the end of the instructional unit.
