Students will receive marks for their overall performance in each course of study using the following letter grade scale.

A = 90-100%

B = 80-89%

C = 70-79%

D = 60-69%

F = 0-59%

Grades of "D" and above are passing marks. A course grade of "F" indicates that the student has failed the course.

For 9th-12th grade levels, no course credit will be awarded for a failing course grade.

All grade entries in the gradebook will be attributed to one of the following categories.

This category includes all items used to measure a student's proficiency toward the learning standards once the student has had sufficient practice and at a specified point in time. This category can include summative tests, performance assessments, reports, unit or module assessments, quizzes, long-term projects, short-term projects, presentations, capstone projects, research paper© .

A zero ("0") will be entered as the score for the assignment in the gradebook
No Evidence (NE) will be entered for the standards attached to the assignment

An assignment is considered late work when the assignment is not submitted by the due date that was established but is submitted within the parameters listed below.

For _____ to be accepted, students must meet the following parameters:

Assignment is not due within the class period

Assignment is not a timed activity (such as a Quick-Write Essay)

Assignment is not a Long-Term assignment (over multiple weeks)

Assignment is turned in within the following time frame: **9-12 Grades: By the end of the unit**
