[i-Ready](#)

i-Ready is the online component of our math curriculum. We use this website for:

- Diagnostic assessments
- Math fact fluency practice
- Math games to reinforce previously learned skills
- Individualized lessons
- Tests and quizzes (must be completed in class)

[IXL](#)

IXL is a supplemental website used for weekly math homework to review and reinforce previously learned skills.

Students must:

- Get to at least 80 Smartscore points (due every Friday by 8am)
- Show their work for at least 5 problems (paper due at the beginning of class each Friday)

Canvas will be used to house video lessons and exit tickets when students are absent. While it is not a substitute for in-class instruction, it is a good resource to help students stay caught up.
