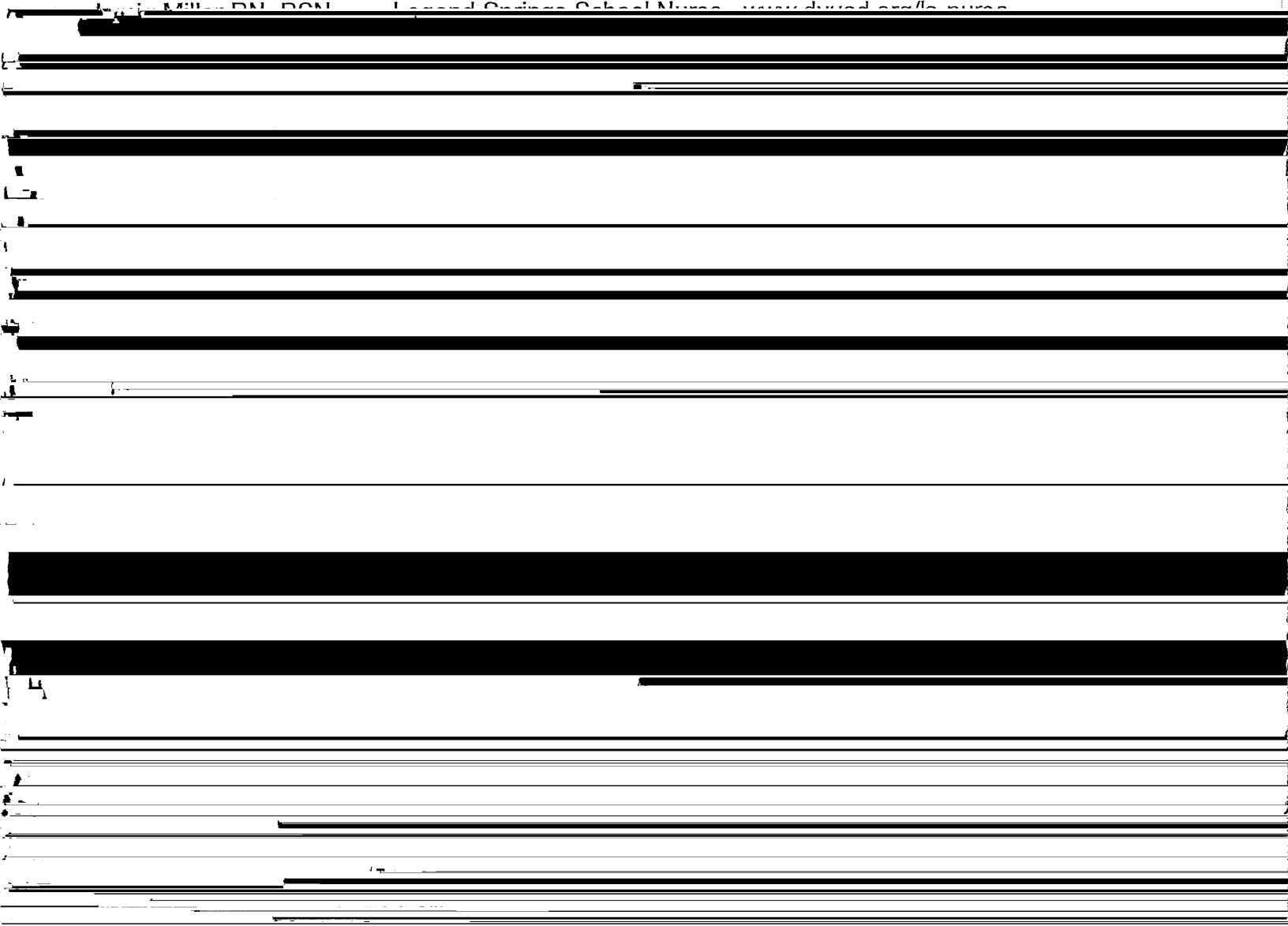


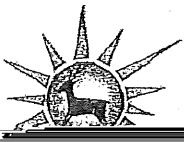

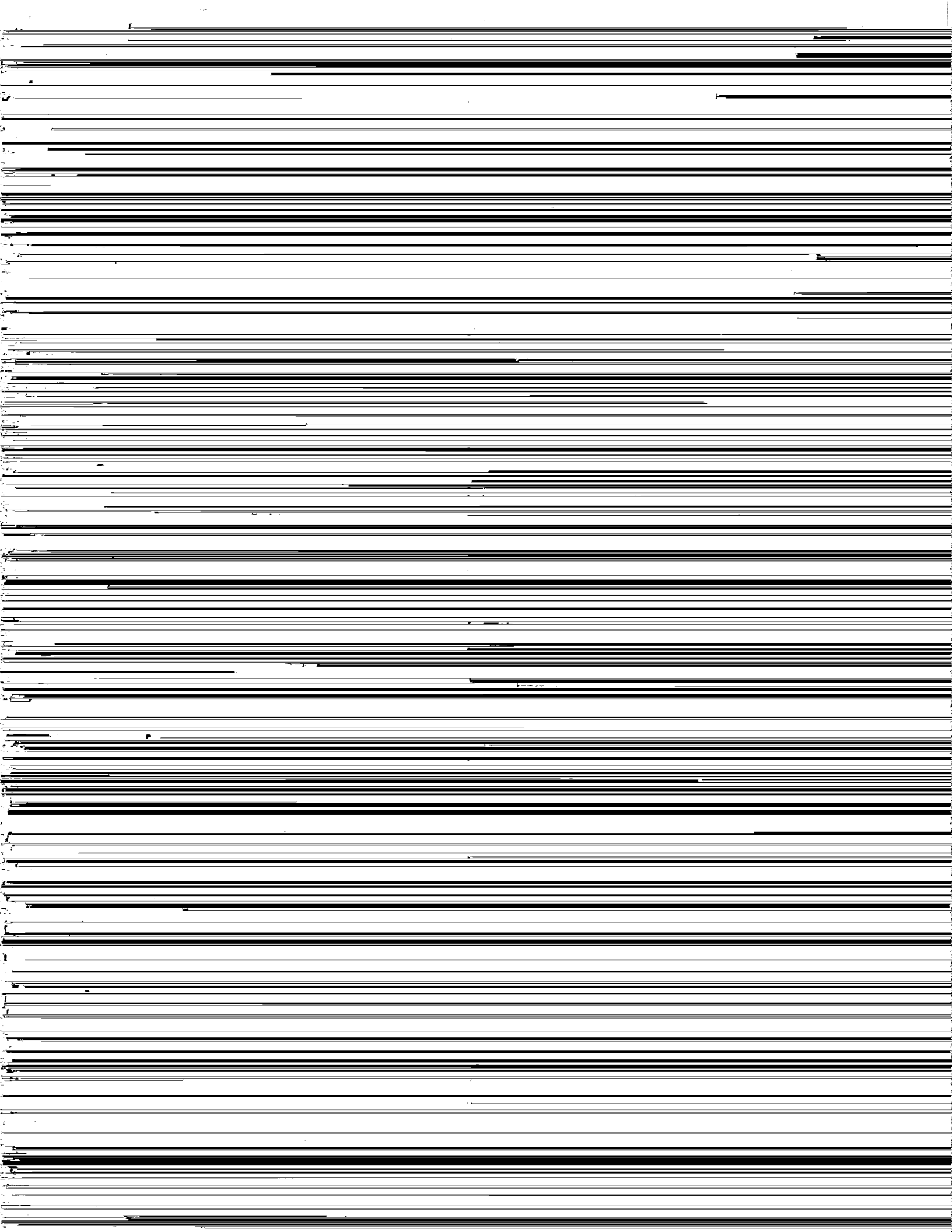

STASV



The prevalence of anaphylaxis is increasing. Epinephrine is the only recognized first-line treatment for anaphylaxis and must be given promptly. Epinephrine is underutilized in anaphylaxis treatment. All other drugs have a delayed onset of action.

EPIPEN (EPINEPHRINE) AUTO-INJECTOR DIRECTIONS:

Remove the EpiPen Auto-Injector from the plastic carrying case. Remove the BLUE safety release cap.
