
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For addi onal informa on, the parent may click the blue "show standards" icon to view the proficiency marks for the learning standards associated with the assessment or coursework.

If the work is submi ed as Late Work (see below), the assignment score will be changed to reflect the student's actual score with no deduc ons or penal es.

Even though they will be trace credit for the assignment, they will sell be disciplined through the Union Park Discipline Matrix for this behavior choice.
