

Your children may qualify for free or for reduce-price meals. The reduce-price meals will also be free throughout this cool year, as DVUSD has waived the reduced price meal-pagy for both breakfast and lunch.

Our schools often paticipate in programs that your child may benefit from if your child qualifies for free or reduce price meals. - 1. WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR FREE MEALS?
- a. All children in households receivingenefits from SNAP, FDPIR (Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations) or TANF can get free meta regardles of your income.
- Foster children that are under the legal responsibility of a foster care agency or court are eligible for fr meals.

You are encouraged to complete an online application instead of a parapplication if you are ablethe onlineapplication has the same requirements and will ask you for the same information as the paper application.
